Helen Blackbear: Ray, what about that hill south of there, where Mark Sadonke used to live. I thought Daddy told you one time there was an Apache man buried over there. That everybody's afraid of that hill.

Ray Blackbear: Yea, just south of Mark's house.

Helen: Daddy, he say they afraid of that hill. He say Apache man there, medicine man.

Ray: Still further south, that's where them boys froze. They run away from Riverside, they froze down there, caused a big commotion. Kiowa's went down there and had it out with the superintendent.. Like to kill him.

Helen: It's not at Riverside. It's that Kiowa school, they call it at Anadarko.

Ray: Used to be right across from Riverside. Across the river.
