## GUNS--UNUSUAL MAKES

(Well, that makes it bad if they had guns and knives.)

They had funny looking pistols too. They have a gun like that and had a trigger on the side.

(I never seen one like that.)

I guess you've seen shot guns that way. It sits on top, but the pistol is on the side.

(On the side--well, that would be funny looking thing.)

I have never seen one no where since then.

(No, I never did see one like that.)

We found a shot gun one time when we went to a meeting up here at the mouth of the creek, they called it. Old Man Buckskin went along and his brother's boy, call him Sam, and another guy went too. We just had
