Yeah, there was way and a sawmill way back to the 20's. There was some pretty good timber back in these hills. People paid to saw logs, you know. What happened to most timber in this country back then they made railroad ties out of it. Didn't let it grow up too high.

(Yeah)

Put that large sawmill in here. And that was one of the main things they done here. Made these ties and hauled 'em, you know. Didn't work in the fields. Made them ties out of lots of timber.
