I think they did. I can't be sure. Here's an Alfred Secondine.

And two infant Secondines. One in '87 and one '85. That must have been and Ike and Liza Secondine's children because they lost some as babies. William H. Marshall. Isn't there another William Marshall here? They had five or six children. They separated, when that girl died they did. And then she married Al. And then they had a bunch of kids. So--

(That was Joe and Liza's Secondine's then they--)

They were husband and wife to begin with. And then they separated and Joe died. Joe died over by Bartlesville. Over there on--oh, 9th street, oh, was that the street? Anyway, it was over towards Bartlesville. Well, that's probably some of their children. See there's Jane. That was a mighty clever name among all those people, see. Jim Secondine. And they have a different spelling of that, don't they?

(They do.)

Secondine.

(I noticed that was unusual.)

There's a parcel of Secondines out there.

(I was wondering whoever made the marker stone spelled it the way they wanted to.)

Well, I just don't know.

(I've found out that happens.)

Well, yes, that's true. Laura Mayberry and Emmett Mayberry. 1902,
