One brother, and that my sister, me and my sister and one brother, we had one mother. One, no my brother and my sister we all had one mother. But my daddy was different. He was a Ketcher and our daddy was a Cockeram.

Cause he was just our half-brother. This is the only full sister I got. Right here, Miss Wayne (?) Yeah, she's the only-- And the rest of them is half-sisters and half-brothers.

(So there 's two sets of you, Ketchers and Cockerams?)

Had eleven I believe. There's eleven of us children all one daddy. But different mothers. But I think there's just about nine or ten of us living now.

(And they're all scattered?)

Yeah, some of them passed away, dead. Yeah, eleven or twelve or somewhere along there, had one daddy but we had all different mothers. Yeah. But this is the only one I have that's my whole sister to me. We have one living, one dead. And my brother, well, we had one brother, well, that's Robert Ketcher. He lives at Okmulgee. But he's a Ketcher. That's my half-brother. There was just three of us had one mother.

(And you name was, then was--?)

Cockeram.

(Cockeram. And then you've got some half-brothers and sisters that were Ketcher. Do I understand it right?) No, I've just got one half-brother by the name of Ketcher. All the rest of them is Cockeram. My brothers and sisters. But they all got different mothers. So we got one daddy, that's half-sisters and half-brothers. Got one daddy though, but different mothers.
