Yeah, even before my time.

(Well, now, wasn't this where Eureka community through here?)

Yeah, the old Eureka school used to be about a mile up here. Close old Eureka store. Perhaps, you don't remember though when about Moss had a store here, did you?

(Huh-uh, no, I don't remember any store at all, Uncle Elzie.)

Well, I remember -- I've heard of the Eureka store. And Bob Moss used to run the store. You know, he later had a store over at Gaber over there at the (not clear), you know.

(Uh, I tell you what, if it wains, we might just ought to walk over there.)

You may be right. There is a little slick hill over there.

(I like to walk, anyway. And whose place did you say this was?)

Well, he knows more than I tell you. (not clear) school building place is all I can remember. Well, I -- there's several--seems to me that was in that store. I mean, at times, you know, but I know Bob Moss had a store here at one time.

(Bob was about the last one (not clear).

I imagine he was because when he sold it (nto clear) .

(-- telephone, and I'm going over here, and I'm (not clear) cemetery.)

I'm going to look around. Don't let this cat in the house now.
