Sunnyside, all around Sunnyside. We lived in a farming community. And I was Centerville School, and, of course, the school house is all gone now. (Yeah, Centerville.)

Centerville. It's located on a section -- Section 8, 23, and 18.

(Twenty-three and eighteen.)

And it was there before statehood for quite a little while.

(Let's see, how far south of Tulsa was Sunnyside?)

Well, Sunnyside was southeast of Tulsa.

(Southeast, that's on (?) .)

Yeah, Sunnyside was two miles south and, let's see, no, it was -- how far south.

(Looks like it's about three miles?)

It was further than that.

(Maybe, it was.)

No, it wasn't -- some (not clear). The Bison (?) Ranch is just mile south of Tulsa. From there, it'd be two miles south, and about three mile east, two miles south and three miles east.

(It was in Mayes county, though, wasn't it, or was it in Roger county?)
No, it's in Mayes county.

(Mayes County.)

Rogers county is just on the line north of the line north.

(Just in the -- west of there, there's an old Dawes place. Now, was there a school house there at one time anywhere?)

No where, no where. There was a school house in, let's see, I was in down in the center of Hughes school, close to the Dawes community, close to the Dawes Cemetery.

(Would that have been it, the old location, about a mile east of there on
