

No, they got rattle, with cow's hoof. You know, little bit. All bunched up tied up. Sure sound pretty. And a little bell you know they always have. About that long, (6 inches) with a handle. They shake it like that. Yea, that's what they do.

(Did they ever take peyote in Ghost Dance meetings?)

No, they don't go with peyote. The peyote's outside. You don't go with it.

(Was peyote going at about that same time?)

No, them days them peyote people, long time, they don't wait for Saturday night, no. They just have it any time when they get ready. But now, new timer, they just use..go in Saturday, unless it's somebody's birthday or somebody sick, they wait to Saturday. But this Ghost Dance different.

(What kind of things did the people who belong to the Ghost Dance Church believe in?)

Well..their believe in God, they pray to God. 'sí' 'ásé means our father, God. xi-dà'á, Jesus our brother Jesus. That's what they always prayed. They prayed, some people, some school children. And sometime they want their war, they have to pray for their homes or thier children, like that. That's what they pray for. I hear them pray to God to Jesus. That's what I know.

(Did they ever make prayers for food?)

Well, they don't eat in there. One Sunday you know when they quit they go home and they eat at home. When they eat at home they pray then for food. Course, they pray in the afternoon when they go in again, they don't eat in there. Just a special for a church going on.

(Do you remember any of the words to the Ghost Dance songs?)

Oh I sure forgot a lot of songs. (Louise sings an Apache Ghost Dance song.)
