full-bloods do. You, full-bloods, pay big taxes. And I want to get that back. So, you people can get your money back. what I'm working. And the next one, is this extension. We just got one more year. It will be up next year. 1959. It's going to be up. And I don't know what we're going to do then. you people going to do, but we/work. The mixed-blood, we work. We make more money than what we get from you people, from our people. I put myself in there too. We just get \$50.00 a month to go in that council room and sit there. We could make more money outside than we can sit in there all day long. \$50.00 a month. That's all we get from tribal funds. Well, that's just one day, ain't it? Yeah, its one day, and no more for a long time. We get \$50.00 a month is all we get. But I'm working on these three things. But I doubt this one, but I'm sure I'm going to get these two. You're going to get your tax refund. I'm working on it, I'm paying everybody in there now. And then extension, I want to extend for more free of this mineral right. 'Cause lot of us sold our land. Lot of you, full-bloods sold your land, and no oil on it. You sold it. But when they drill on it, we're getting that money under the ground. The white man get the top, but we get it under that. to hold that on. And that's what I'm working on, he said. Them two things. I'm pretty sure I'm going to get it. I'm about to get it. So, I come down to tell you. What do you think about it? Well, Mr. Labadie, I think that's very nice of you. been the only full-blood, I thank you. I thank you for my tribe, young and old. I thank you for your hard work. You been working for us. I been hearing that. You work hard, day and night. Try to help us, to get this extension and this and that, that and that. Yeah. Well, he got that refund, you know. Later on, he got that refund, tax refund. We got lot of taxes returned back to us. And I saw him, (Osage name), right here. White House, where Eisenhower was. And there was Eisenhower was facing this way and there's two more men standing over there. One man standing here, one man here and one over here by Eisenhower. You know, Eisenhower was--(End of Tape)
