Before they go, before they go last day, last day, them Pawnees have--call it the brush dance. From their camp, where they're camping clear to dance arbor they have brush dance all the way over there. When they get there, they told where to sit. Sit half circle. Them Pawnees, they have otter skin, otter skin great hair Dress up. The Poncas do that long ways when they come over here. Do the same thing. Way I understand it, the Poncas gave that drum to Grayhorse Indians. Gave it to 'em. I guess, I don't know what they think about it. Anyway, they give the drum to them. /Words not clear./ They took it. Took everything. Ponca ain't got nothing. They dance over there, but the drum--I don't know how they dance. They give all that stuff, all that stuff. They gave it to the Pawhuska Indians. They didn't have no drum. They ain't got no--they ain't supposed to have those tail dancers or whipman. All they can do is sing. Sing, he drummers, that's all. 'Cause they got all the rest of it. Pawhuska Indians got it. Us down here, the Kaw Indians, they come down there. They wanted give the Hominy
