

or childrens that pass away. But I don't suppose they ever did come to see them. But they just call it that, you knowcall it Ghost Dance.

(How did they dance? Did they just dance in one place like the Blackfeet dancers or did they move around?)

They move around lots. Some mens be holding on to his wife or a man be holding on to some woman, you know. And they be dancing, dancing jump and jump all over that place where they dance and then afterwhile they all sit down when they get tired and they just fall over. Said when they fall over and lay on the ground they could listen....see if they coming...way in the night. They have a big fireplace in the center so they could see one another you know. That's what they call Ghost Dance.

(Have you ever heard of the sun dance?)

Yeah, I seen the Sun Dance

(What was that like?)

They have a....they cut a fork a cotton wood tree. They stand it up in the ground. They have these long poles, cottonwood and they put them together like a tipi. Just fixed like that. But it's mostly cottonwood tree and they leave the limbs on it and it makes shade, you know. It makes shade and when they makes shade, they dance, four mans. And they tied that middle center pole. With buckskin, they tie them on and they go from here....they go back and forth, back and forth all night long. And four nights...four days and four nights they don't drink water.
