(Around Leavensworth.) Close to Leavensworth. It's in that part. And Pratt, Kansas. Now that's Pratt. As I say, one of the Journeycake's really married a Pratt. As I say, she had these three daughters. One of 'em was the one that came to Bartlesville and married /name not clear/. One of 'em married a /not clear/. (When the Delawares came down here, they did have a separate tract of land that the tribe bought did they from the Cherokees?) Well, they just bought it and they could go in if they want to. (But most of ' 'em settle along up there.) Up in here, (Around Nowata and that country.) From Nowata up to the Karsas line. But mama said grandpa just kept--And they was old. He was old as our daddy. In our neighborhood. They'd went to school there. All the thers were up around Nowata, 'Alluwe, Bartlesville. And up in the northern part of --(Do you remember anything of a little place called Winganon?) Yes. Winganon.
