(Are there many people that go to these meetings?) Yes, quite a number. (Where do they have them at?) At the Community House. We have a special place where we meet. (Where is the Community House?) Right there at the Binger Y. (Are there other people that go to the meetings too besides Caddo?) Well, of the Indians, that's Caddos, and any person that's of any degree of Gaddo blood, that's the ones that attend. (Who runs the meetings when they have them?) The chairman. (Is there only one chairman?) Yes, there's a chairman and vice chairman. (Was this Amy that lives down the house here?) Yes. (What's her last name?) Carter, she's a Haskall now. (Is she a Caddo too?) Yeah, she's Caddo. That's (Amy's mother) my aunt. Grandma just had four children. What's her name?) Markis Johnson. (Was this your father's name?) No, his name was Bidoka. (Whose name was Johnson?) Well, that was her father's. (Her father's name?) She had a different father from mine. My father's father died early. (And he was the one that was Caddo?)

Yeah, he was Caddo.
