T-59-2 Yes, both. They all work. (Did they have plows then?) Yes, they had plows then, cause they were government issue. (What sort of things did the children do while the men and the women were working in the fields?) Well, they had various chores to do around the place such as, carrying water or getting wood or something like that. Or out hunting. Maybe rabbits or squirrels or whater they could find. (Did the Caddos go out to hunt buffalo very often?) Yes, they make their seasonal -- they didn't go for throughtout the year like a lot of our prairie tribe neighbors did. They just had certain that they went out to hunt. (What times of the year did they go?) Most generally in the fall of the year when there was no other work to do. (Who would go out for hunting these buffalo?) Well, cartain parties that you know, are capable of going. Generally the younger men. (Did families ever go?) (END OF TAPE)
