They went after it sometime..I can't say when it was. It's been about 3 or 4 years ago. They went after that pole and then they had one Ghost Dance down there. They had a night of it. I didn't go because I was tied up with Doc. I didn't go through the day you just went by evening.

(Is that the pole that is in the museum?)

Yes. It's in the museum now.

(Was it decorated too? Like the one in..)

I can't say because I don't belong to that.

(What's the last time that your group, the bunch you belong to used a pole?)

We never did have no pole.

(You never did?)
