MORE ABOUT CLANS - LEADERS

(But I mean getting back to what we were talking about, that's where the clan come in. Is where we were created, and didn't they represent certain animal or something like that, I mean, or birds or something like that. Some Eagle clans. It's there. Eagle clans.)

Yeah, there is a whole bunch of them. Now there is Leroy Logan(?).

(Eagle.)

Eagle, brown eagle (not clear) white headed and white tail. That what's called
(Osage word). Speckle tail. (Next sentence not clear).

(Oh, there is three different kinds of birds I guess.)

Yeah.

(And I know other tribes has clans, too.)

Yeah, they have but I don't know they have clans, but they a clan (words not clear) all about. The way we Osages, do, when we have some kind of ceremonies. Like my clan, the Sun Clan. Just visit. All gather together and have ceremonies. And when they have a naming of a child in the Sun Clan, they have ceremony they all attend. And nothing but the Sun Clan attend. I didn't know what they do, I was too young. They have ceremonies inside; when they get through they bring a child inside. The man head of the clan, he names the child.
