If it's alright we will let you know." And if it's alright, they go ahead and get ready. And if it's all right they'll move, move close to the place where they are gonna marry the boy off. They cook food--the girl's father or mother and take it over to boys place. They eat it, and if they eat it and if it's all right they'll eat and if they don't they'll bring it back. And if it's all right the other people go over there. And when they get over there and the father and mother and relatives buys groceries and go there and cook there you know. And they go about four days then they cook breakfast, dinner and supper. The father and mother and relations go take food over there. They don't have to cook over there they eat it. Four days then they--they take whatever they got--horses--they take it over to them. (not clear)--to each one and they talk it over first. Maybe somebody don't like it they want something. Something that they can't get and it's hard for them to do. So, they have to do that and go back and get two or more horses. So they--the family hire a man to run the errand and go to the father and mother. The boy's father and mother and say the girl's father and mother or aunt they want two or more horses. And after they look around for two horses and it's all right then. The next day they marry them off.

(The ceremonies lasted four days.)
