the Osage graves. (not clear) southwest of here on that prairie on top of the hill. You see nothing but Indian graves. Down the road nothing but Indian graves. All the Indian graves they saw. That's long time ago. They had a plague of some kind. Everybody--I don't know what it was, but you get sick in, the morning, and about before noon, you die. (not clear) they try to get away from there, couldn't do it. Somebody says that it's that way. It's that way. All that down here die that way (not clear) hill toward Grayhorse. The one on this side of the old ridge, you know, and on the other side of the hill-side there, nothing but Indian graves. Had plague, smallpox, I guess, something. No DOCTORS IN EARLY DAYS - HOME REMEDIES

(You know, back there, I guess you know, they didn't have any doctors of any kind that knew much about an ything like that. Of course, we had-people would back you, you know, and such as that, but something like that, they didn't have anything for it, you know. They didn't know what it was. And I guess--)

That s what I told awhile ago, according to that. (not clear) different Indians, they learn something. They know how to dig these herbs. Somebody learned some herbs by learning herbs for sickness. That's how they learned that. And this buffalo horn there, they get all that (not clear). They kinda (not clear). They use that. (next sentence not clear) That's the way they (not clear). They get away with it. They get a doctor bleed you and they watch, you know.

They watch and-well, they say (not clear) so that's--there's something (not clear). And then quits bleeding. They have such things like that--Osages, you know.

(I guess, if you broke your leg or something like that, they'd fix that too, wouldn't they?)

Yeah. Well (not clear) over here, he said he broke his leg by a wagon. The wagon turned over him, broke his rib, and suffered. So, he didn't know what to do. I forgot the man's name--old man up at Grayhorse. They sent for him, go after, and come to his home, sit down. What he done, he feel all around.
