TALKS ABOUT LITTLE PEOPLE AND STORIES ABOUT THEM

(....and cook inside and the food like that. But there's another one, they want me to discuss when I can and it's about these little people you know. It's kinds, we have them among our people, you know, stories about these little people. And we heard not too long, oh, about couple years ago, there was one seen up around Wynona there by...)

(Between Hominy and Pawhuska.)

(We came between Hominy and Pawhuska, oh, couple years ago, and this woman was on her way to work. And she seen, and then, there's two of them on the road there. Then she described how they look and how they was dressed. And, you, know, they got their, we got the hint about, of course, we have those stories, but we never discuss them too much. And I heard just awhile ago mentioned little, little person...)

Yeah, mmmm-hmmm.

(So, we don't doubt. We don't say it's so. We don't say it's not so. We just, you know how Indians are. We kinds, well, just leave it alone. You know when the old folks tell us don't think about it too much, you know. But we have heard a lot of stories about them.)

Mmam-hmm.

(Some, they were good little people, and some they were kinds mean little people. And I never did know. I never, papa used to tell us, don't be thinking about it too much, you know.

Manum-humm, we got them here right along the Ponca reservation. There's a place, course, you can see them. That is, if you, course, we're, God made us so that we can rest and then sleep. But sometimes people get curious and wanna see things. Well they can see it, you know.

(Yeah, I know)
