had fight dogs went (not clear) they run 'em down. Sometime they get wild turkey, they run under 'em. They catch 'em. (How was -you know I always hear anywhere any stofies--I always hear, seem like Indian always got a dog round, you know. I guess they train these dogs to hunt for 'em. And be useful for him. I mean it wasn't no pet, you know. He had that dog probably like everybody else had, some duties to perform, you know.)

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Some by the dog--you know, sometime they understand their dogs, you know. Rather he was an animal or man or something. They know what that dogs barks, they know what it is. If somebody is gonna die, they had different barking. They understand their dogs, you know. That's why they treat 'em good. ... (Yeah, I guess they did. They--Indians were--had certain powers to--I don't know whether it was powers or not. I mean the knowledge to understand the enimal such as that, you know. And even, I suppose they had this dog before they had the horse.)

I don't know which one was first, the horses or dog.

(We had the horse--I mean the Spaniard brought them horses over.) Yeah.

(We done had dogs here. So I guess when we domesticated these dogs from these wolves and coyotes, I guess we kinda--). All kinds of animals.

Had to use them to protect himself. (And you know too; just like now days, we use dogs to warn us, you know. Like they can smell, they got a keen sense of smell, you know. And they can smell others like you know, deer and all that.)

They use them for deer hunting, too. •

(Yeak.)

(They have those big dogs I imagine for little deers to chase 'en down.)
