The way he interpreted it was scattering. 4

(Ah-huh)

Course his people pull away from the, from this town, see. And made their own town, the call it Broken Arrow.

(Ah-hum)

That's these Indians say they call them, it Broken Arrow, because they scattered away from the main body.

(Yeah)

That's his interpretation, there. The white people says, there was a mine down there. You turn left.

(Oh, we go left.)

Oh, that's alright, now we let this guy pass. We let these two guy pass, and turn left.

## COWETA

(Now Coweta, that was the name of an old Indian Town, down in Alabama, wasn't it?)

Yeah, that was the first, that was the strongest town there, was.

(Ah-hum)

It was made up of several little towns that they whip, see.

(Ah-hum)

And that's my town, there.

(Is there a translation for the word Coweta?)

No, it/s just Coweta.

(It's just town.)

That's the town.

(Hum)

That is, that much we have found out so far, Coweta.
