Over here on a hill, and all the time it was back when I was born.

(Yeah. Well, there is a lot of Indian folks lived along Salina Creek.

This New Jordon Creek or Wickliff Creek or did I--)

This right here?

(Yeah!)

New Jordon!

(New Jordon Creek.)

Far end of Jordon Creek, I don't know where in the world they got that name. But since I can remember they've had it. It's called New Jordon. That's the name they got for the church.

(Yeah. But now they call this the Grass Cemetery though. Who was the old man Grass?)

Jess Grass.

(Yeah. Old Man Jess. That must of been--)
