Mrs. Vowel: As a whole lot they were, I think. There was always a band, a bunch of men that were mean. Because I didn't even know that until this last year. Up by Detroit before they had moved to Ohio, before Christianity was brought to them. They killed—a band of the Wyandottes killed a, I think it was a priest, or a post military man. Brutally murdered him.

And it was right after that, that Christianity came to them.
