(Do you know how many boys and girls?)

They just got three girls and seven boys.

(Do any of them have children?)

Yeah, they're all growing. I think the oldest one is Joe. The second one is Clifford. And the third one is Ralph. And then they got Tommy Rose—a girl. And then Lawerence. Let's see—Clifford, Joe, Ralph, Tommy Rose, Lawrence—La-Verne, and Sterling—a boy. And Charles. And then Frances—a girl. And then this girl—what's her name, this baby? Mary something. Ten—ten kids. Oh, my, you sure got me! I thought I was just going to answer a few! (laughs) You just lead me into all that! You trap me! Clifford is got two kids—a girl and a boy. Me no savvy their names!

(His wife, is she Arapaho?)

She's a Kiowa. I don't know her name.

(Then what about Charles--does he have any?)

No.

(And Sterling -- does he have any?)

No.

(Does Joe?)
