naetaesihae' ae

Yeah.

(What would he say, if he's talking to two wives or three wives?)

Now you got me--(Pause, thinking)--oh, I know. naetaesihae' w w w

-- that means all of his wives. naetaesihae' w w w

(Could he use that term if he's talking about all of his wives to someone else?)

Yeah, yeah. naetaesihae' w w w

(And what about if it was back in the old days and you were a woman and you married a man that's got more than one wife. And you want to talk to the other wife--what would you call her if you're talking right to her?)

Well, haetaesin w

(Would you say that one again?)

haetaesin w --that means your husband--all of them, you know--all his wives if he had twenty.

(Now could a woman use that talking to her husband's other wife?)
