seen that Snake Dance. But I used to hear about it. Grandma used to tell us they used to have a Snake Dance.

(Was it anything like this one they have now?)

I guess. I don't know. I never did see it. Never seen Snake Dance before--but oh, it's not very long ago they been dancing Snake Dance.

And then that Buffalo Dance, I don't think it goes in there.

(How come?)

Oh, they're not no buffaloes. Buffalo Dance, they used to be chiefs that used to dance that. And they didn't have no Snake Dance at that time. You know these people that putting on these pow-wows--they're mostly just putting it on for show, and they just dance anything they want to.

(Do you ever remember seeing a Buffalo Dance where there were just the chiefs dancing?)

No. I never did see one.

(Do you know what occasions they might have it?)

I don't know--I just used to hear of Buffalo Dance, that's all. I never did see it and never did know how it was--until now, I see this go up and down (modern Buffalo Dance). I don't know how this (old) Buffalo Dance was.

SCALP DANCE

They used to.

(Did the Arapahoes have a dance they called the Scalp Dance?)

(What was it like?)

Well, they just always dance like they dance these Round Dances, but they dance fast, and they got different songs. And they used to say when they go out fighting and they used to scalp, you know--maybe a white man or a
