lands put back into a rehabilitation program for the benefit of the Cherokees who live there.

A The money from the lease, from this particular project, goes into a fund which is then used for that fund and it is used to maintain some of the buildings that are on there, and that's about all that it is used for, really, because that takes most of it.

Q In the management of those lands you mentioned a Board of Trustees. What are their duties?

A They make recommendations to the chief of the tribe and to the Bureau for the management and use of the land.

Are they paid employees of the Bureau or of the tribal structure?,

A No.

Q Do they spend --

A They are not paid by the Bureau. I believe they are paid certain per diem and expenses from the tribe and funds or from this income. I'm not sure.

to whether the management of those lands is management by the Bureau or by the tribe -- by the Cherokee Nation?

A No.

The lands are the responsibility of the Bureau?
