 7 not only of the person but of the place.

8 THE COURT: Except one little  
 9 item. There is nothing in any of the treaties you cited  
 10 that gave the Indian tribes a right to hunt and fish.  
 11 None of the treaties. None of the tribes indigenous to  
 12 Oklahoma have a treaty that gives them the right to hunt  
 13 and fish. If you have anything to the contrary I want  
 14 to hear it.

15 MR. KAMINS: We would stipulate  
 16 that there are no specific hunting or fishing treaties  
 17 similar to what the --

18 THE COURT: Hunting and  
 19 fishing rights under any treaty.
