There's some Indians in Hobart. Yea, we got a clinic here. But I can say that about the hospital, they really treated my daughter alright, because she got all that she wanted. You know, they really got a good surgery. They had to patch that, they got the skin off of her leg, and they had to put it on this other one.

(How about the University Hospital?)

Yea, but you have to go through a lot of red tape. You got to go to the county commissioner, and you know. They gotta recommend you to the University Hospital. I know that's what I did. The same, this one, their mother, she had that rheumatic fever, you know, and she was swollen all over, and we had to go to the commissioner, and he had to sign first before she was admitted. But now, she's on the welfare, and she's on this disability, and she got in there. Since she had this last baby, why it had that hairlip. You know, she's in there. She can go any time they call her, well, she can go there. But I don't know, rest of us, I don't think we can go.

(What kinds of improvements in clinics would you like to see?)

Well, we usually get what we wanted, like supplies, like his pills, you know, I go down here and get it. Then I go over to the hospital and get it. I think that's alright. Well, we went all over (for a chair), and they said there were funds there that he could buy a chair (at the office), but we just didn't want to fool with them anymore because they just turn us down so many times. He had to pay for that, and he ain't got no money. They won't help him. You still owe hundred dollars balance. He's got to go see his lease man. But this one (chair) oh, it's heavy. It's got more chrome on it. It's stout. They had to order it from Los Angeles.
