mule. There's that much difference in them two things. And I don't know.

(What is the difference?)

Well, the oil and gas lease, they're going to put them up for bids, -sealed bids. Probably some of them will go beyond three hundred dollars an acre. Maybe some of them go down to about two and a half an acre. It just varies. And they won't give you whatever their bid is..they just give you a big bonus. They give you a big bonus. Beyond that big bonus, you get maybe a dollar and a half an acre. There's that much difference. But farming and grazing, they'll pay you according to the acreage. But now some of these farm lands, a quarter will bring right close to two thousand dollars a year. But your oil and gas don't do that. They might sound awful big when they pay that bonus, but after that bonus it's just rock bottom and that's one thing I wish by George there was some kind of change in that leases. All these leases ought to be on the same category as farming and grazing. All the same. That way, our people won't be confused. They're confused anyway they turn. They even confused in the church. Why? Too many different denominations. Each denomination will, tell our people, our denomination are the truth the only one. My people they can hardly stand still. I know, cause I. worked among them, among these places, churches.
