Mostly Wichitas, well, they--they just use this one right here like that, and towards--it's--it's the same dance though with Gourd Dance, Man Dance; but reason why they got this way, some ain't got nothing, maybe, got feathers.

(Yeah.)

But they holler, you know, towards the end of the song when they quit.

They hit like that, you know.

(Yeah, yeah.)

(laughter) I tell you, nobody holler--holler like that but the women, you know. They're (not clear) supposed to, you know.

(When--when do the Wichita do the Gourd Dance or Man Dance?)

Well. Only thing I can--I can tell is they come in clans.

(Mmm-hmm.)

See, the Wichitas have Gourd Clan just like that. If somebody--somebody, member of a clan, he puts it out, you know. Say, I'm going plan to have it, this dance same time. Maybe, during--anytime of the season, you know, whenever one of them say, "We're going to try to put this one," you know.

(Yeah.)

They all have to be there.

(Yeah.)

See, they had a Gourd Clan, but we just got this War Dance from the Pawnees.

(Yeah.)

It's not ours.

(Yeah.)

But the Gourd Dance and this Wolf.

(Mmm-hmm.)
