(Yeah.)

I don't know what they carry. There's a -- sometimes, you know, it's funny.

(Yeah.)

And big camp at Wichita, you know, you can find that kind, you know.

(Yeah, yeah.)

Keep it, you know.

(Yeah.)

Well, he had one. Yeah, but I don't know what he done with it. We should have kept it, you know. There's lot of things, you know. They just -- people just, you know, had pipe.

(Yeah.)

I think he had three pipes. One of them got -- I think one man got two of them pipes and got the gourd, that doughnut. Doughnut, boy, I don't know whether you saw him.

(No.)

I don't know who made them, but my grandfather used to make them. He used a pipe too.

(Yeah.)

(Not clear) one, you know, like that.

(Yeah.)

I think Mac Steve's got both of them gourds, but my mother owned a -- owned a (not clear), and the other one I think belongs to the Pankerd, you know.

(Yeah.)

He got them, you know. about that big, you know.

(Yeah.)

And the other one, wound one, got a hole in the middle there. It's -- I don't know. They used it in these -- well, I don't know.
