There were so many vicious animals and all that that why you couldn't afford to, so they always make that pretty high you know. The swing for a child.

(Did they keep that hammock in any special room?)

No. It's always out in the yard. If a person is working then they always have something to cover the child. A lot of times they swing them and then when the child goes to sleep they just let it go and then that's the baby tender while the mother is working.

(Do older children take care of the baby?)

Yes, uhuh. They stay around the place and call the mother's attention in case the child awakens.

(Was there anyone that took care of you other than your mother?)

My grandmother lived in the next house. We had several log cabins down
