Well what I mean a shroud is a garment you put on the deceased.

(Oh, you put...)

Such as moccassins or clothing, shirt's and so on. Dresses or whatever you have.

(Do the Caddo use old style Indian clothing, in this?)

Yes, whuh, most of the older ones.

(What about on top of the coffin? Do you put anything on it?)

No.

(Do people still put things in graves with people?)

Well some of them do. That is they don't always put everything there. It's just the very personal things that you have. Perhaps something that you dearly loved or perhaps something that you originated. Because that's one of the reasons I guess that they're digging up a lot of these places in Texas because that's what one of the men told me because I've got a lot of pottery and so in here in the house that come from there.

(A lot of `powdery?)

## POTTERY MAKING:

Pottery.

(Oh, pottery.)

Uhuh.

(Well do, people still put pottery in graves?)

Well if they have it but back in Texas where they come from they're exhuming all of those things like that.

(Did you ever make pottery when you were growing up?)

Yes. I teach that pottery work. Since I teach afts and crafts that's one of my lines.
