Use that red clay and that white clay.

(Where do you get the clay at?)

Right here on the phace.

(Oh, you do?)

Uhuh.

(Do you heat your pottery after you make it?)

Oh, you mean, well, yes if you make it the old style you do bake it.

I just stick mine in the oven. Let them go at that.

(Do you put special designs on them?)

Yes, you can paint them after they're..and then gloss them over.

(What do you gloss them with?)

Well there's various things; that you can use. You can use commercial products now which is a whole lot easier.
