(Did they have more than one meeting a week?)

Uh, like my church now, they just have at every Fourth Sunday 'cause the preachers are kind of scarce now, you know. They have a circuit. My church belongs to a circuit, Honeycreek circuit, and there's four churches in the circuit. And one preacher goes to one church one Sunday and to the next church the next Sunday, like that. Uh-huh.

(Is your preacher an Indian?)

Uh-huh.

(Do most of the Indian people go to this church?)

Uh-huh.

(Does he speak in English or...?)

No, in Creek.

(How old is he?)

I don't know how old our new pastor is now, they change them about every year. I don't know who my new pastor is now. They have an Indian mission in June, or about three weeks ago. They send us a new preacher. I hardly go up there. I go to this Baptist and I go (not clear) mostly.

(Did your children go...?)
