And I had a big bread pan about that square, and I fixed a bread pan full of biscuits every morning. And we had our own butter and we would have sorghum. That's what we had, fried potatoes, fried meat, biscuits, butter and sorghum.

(And you made your own butter?)

Uh-huh.

(What did you have for lunch?)

Oh, beans. Brown - I used to fix biscuits and cornbread for dinker.

(What did you have for dinner?)

Left-overs. We still do.

(You had your big meal_in the morning?)

Yeah, breakfast and dinner.
