No, they didn't go anywhere. No they didn't go to Florida, or anywhere. They mostly stayed home in winter time.

(What effect did this wealth have on the Indian dances?)

Well, I think my people were free-hearted people - they always did give - even before this big money came in. They used to give so much away.

Especially horses in those days, horses were valued, and ah - they gave away a good many horses. And therefore - and blankets - they had blankets in those days. And they were free hearted people - and they feed a lot of people. They took care of 'em - and they gave to 'em - because they come and visiting - and they have their dances together. So I think, as far as the money concerned, they didn't change the matter any - they were always a free giver.

(What tribes have been closer to the Osages in Oklahoma - what Indian tribes?)

Well, I couldn't say about that - because I don't know just how to answer that - Unless Eddy could say something on that.

(What - Well wha -)

He might know what tribe, would be the nearest. Because we have never really associated with - only just to visit. We use to visit one tribe one summer, and next summer they visit someone else. Somewhere - So that's the only way that they have carried on - But as far as being closer to any tribe I think they were all Indians - and that's the way they looked at.

(They've never really been close to any particular tribe?)
