already dried and everything-how do you use it when you get ready to cook it or fix it?)

Well, I, we cook it with sweet corn and pork with it. Pork. And maybe if we don't cook corn with it--maybe just a pumpkin and pork. And maybe just plain--nothing but pumpkin. Put little sugar in there, and it's sweet.

(What do you do? Boil it?)

Boil it. Kinda boil it down. Kinda not soupy. And you put a little sugar in it. It's good that way. That's the way we cook it.

(Do you cook it outside or ...?)

Out side, Always be outside.

(Does it take very long for it to bet done?)

Takes almost an hour.

(Do you ever cook the pumpkin while it's fresh?)

Umhumm.

"(How do you fix it then?)

You cook it in a water, and sometimes we fry it. We cook it--we put a little water there and put the pumpkin in there and just cook and when its done, we take it out.

(How do you fry it?)

You put grease in--, just like you fry potatoes. Just like you fry---Slice it. Slice it and fry it. It's good.

(I never tasted fried pumpkin. You know, I'd like to come back next fall and get you to show me how to dry some, it sure sounds good. Well, can you think of anything else?)

No, I don't have anything else to say.
