Eventually conquered by the white man and literally forced into modern civilization what use to be the plight of the American Indian. Once a carefree people, termed by the religious set as probably one of the tribes of Isreal. The Indian can no longer live the secluded life their ancestors. According to reliable information, 1/5 of the Indians in the United States reside in Oklahoma. In fact, the name Oklahoma means the land of the red man. The state, composed of Indian territory and Oklahoma territory was admitted into the Union in 1907. Some 30 tribes are to be found in the state with Kiowas, Comanches and Kiowa-Apache and a -- of Geronimo Apaches, some Caddoes, Delawares and others in the southwestern section. There are no reservations in this area. The tribesmen and thier family reside on restricted 160 acre allotments, granted them when finally arrangements were made with the signing of the Jerome agreement in 1892. Trouble between the Indiasns in Oklahoma and the government subsided with the signing of the Medicine Lodge Kansas treaty in 1867. Included in the various tribes were whites, Mexicans, some Negroes and others captured and reared with the Indians. They wre also given allotments and shared equal privileges. Members of several tribes were grouped together, such as was done in the early days when there were German, Bohemian and other nationalities residing in settlements. The Kiowas were in one area, the Comanches in another and the Kiowa-Apaches in another. Geronimo's Apaches relaeased
