That's the only one. Only two things somebody not to go back of you when they eat. You walk behind me but it's not bad as they carry meat behind me when I eat. It looks funny you know and when anybody—my folks—my family's around I'm eating at the table when anybody going to go behind me. "Don't go behind there." They all take care of me because some day one of them might get sick and they have to come to me to doctor. That's why they always look out for me when I'm eating—my own family. They all know that I'm like that. That's my rule what my mother gave me—do that.

(Did she have the same rule?)

Uh-huh. She had that same rule.

(Did she have another one?)

No. That's all she had. (background noise)

## IMPORTANCE OF EAGLE FEATHER IN DOCTORING

(Now is that because you use the eagle feather?)

Un-huh that eagle like that nobody can go behind.

(Can you tell me now where did you get (noise in background) -- you say you have two eagle feathers, where did you get them?)

The first one was from my Uncle Jess Rowlodge. He lives up here. He's Arapaho. And the second one when I doctored them he gave it to me. I got thee. I got three eagle. I never did us these two what was given to me. You know they give it to me for present. They were glad they got well. They gave it to me. I got two estra ones besides this other one. But this other one, one I had, long time now, my mother gave me. She gave me all that things, (not clear--lots of background noise--dogs still howling.) If anybody handle it--just, like this kid if she handle it, he have to go wash his hand--just go off and not wash his hand and we don't allow of kids handle it. We don't want--yeah eagle--and we don't want it to be among people where they--there's lot of people. We don't want it to be like that--around people. We don't
