Alfred: Well, to get back to where they start singing, you know-somehow, they rake around and got a drum. When they got that drum-Evelyn: Your mother's the one that bought that drum.

Alfred: Well, the next thing I know--boy they had the phythm! And finally they got together and they want to remodel some of these staffs. So they got--I don't know whose overcoat they got--but they took that to wrap around that staffs. They had two of them with a hook. The
