(Oh, you did?)

(Oh, you did? George Young?)
On top of the hill.

Unhumh. That's where we live. Five years, eight years. I went to live way out. Me and son live together out there. Live close to Barber, Barber, Oklahoma, Store on this side. We live seven years in there.

CHURCH

(Did you ever have any other kind of meeting around here in the old days?)

(Church meetings or anything here at the house? Did they have churches in here then when you were a 'little girl?)

Yes.

(Just kinda Mission churches like they are today?)

Yes. Yeah. We live - well my birthday - lets see, August 5th, we had a service up here too.

(Were the Cherokees back in here pretty good church members back in the early days when you were a little girl?)

Yeah.

(Was there much in way what you would call Indian doings when you were a little girl?)

(Dances, stomp dances or things going on?)

MOTHER LIKED TO DANCE

Unhunnh. Mamma used to go stomp dance. They used to have stomp dance up there, not too far. - 'bout two or three, two miles on hill up here, year
