(Sewing?)

Unhunnh Yeah. Sewing. Make quilts. Sewing.

AFRAID OF FIRST WHITE MAN SHE SAW

(Were there many white people in here when you were a little girl?)

(No white people?)

No. I don't see - That's all I seen. In school you know its not white people. Its just they can talk English. That's all. Cherokee Teacher. You know that's all I see. First time - I know first time we come up here, white people they was in Stillwell though. And name was George Whitson and he come in here and hunt turkey - wild turkey. Yeah, and deer. He come up here and haul a big old wagon bed. Got seat. Wagon you know. You remember that?

(Yes)

And they got horse team. He brought up here. Leave wagon up here. We cook right there somewhere and he camp right there. He hunt turkey and deer and squirrel. Some days, I guess November - its not season close that time. It's 'bout winter time.
