That's all I know. He come - white people.

· (Did the Indians object to them coming in and hunting?)

We, - oooooooh I'm afraid of 'em that white man. Mamma said, "He wont do nothing. He is just going hunting." I couldn't understand what he said. I didn't understand nothing. He said - how are you. He said it like this.

(You_stay. there?)

Yes. Sometime maybe her give me something. I don't know, maybe candy.

Maybe some light bread. He told me "Come and get it." Yeah. So I
guess that's what he said. If I understand it, he was hold like this.

Oh I run in the house. I am afraid some wild Indian out there. (Laughter)

He is wild Indian to me. And Rene Fletcher. Rene Fletcher's daddy, he used to come up here. You know that was in the woods up there was lots of wild turkey.

MANY WILD TURKEYS

(All around here?)

Yeah. All around here. They come up here to kill turkey. You can see the gobblers up there. You can hear - You know early in morning, you know up there and back this way. That's what they waitin' on and roost, you know.

(Bid the Indian people get many of 'em?)

Money?

(Many of the gobblers?)

Oh, yeah...

(Did they trap 'em or shoot 'em?)

Shoot 'em.

(Deer, I guess, are still in here aren't they?)
