(Who were the older Cheyennes advising the young ones not to go up there?)

Well, I just heard that. They said it was being talked around. But that's what happened. That's why no descendants went up there that I know of. Oh, they might have come a day or two later just as spectators to the pageant--I did see some--but anyway. The only bunch that Hailman Little Coyote that took care of the Cheyennes had was his own family--all dancers with good costumes, and maybe two or three other. So, Roy Nightwalker, who was from Seiling, also, where Little Coyote is from, I took him in on my list because of his part-Arapaho family. Before we got to Medicine Lodge I went to Canton and paid them off for their expenses up there. And I saw one of Black Kettle's descendants. His name was Jay Black. He's an old man--three or four or five years older than I am. He was on the street. I asked him, "Why ain't you going up?" "No, I'm not going," he said. "It's not a peace treaty." I said, "Well, you've been up there before." "Yeah, I know it," he said, "But I had to go that time on account of my folks." So, they had just a small bunch, the Cheyennes. That was the reason.

(Did Roy Nightwalker come in with your group?)

He was to come in on my group--I had him on my list. But when he got up there Hailman Little Coyote had such a few that Roy had rather go to Hailman so he could get more rations, I guess. So I let him go, with his family. I didn't have them on my Arapaho list.

(Where does Hailman Little Coyote live?)

He lives at Seiling. I think his mother or some relative lives up at Medicine Lodge. I saw her at the parade. She come over and shook hands with me. I said, "Well, I haven't seen you for a long time, where have you been?" "I live here," she said. "I live about twelve miles northeast of here." "I didn't know that. I'm glad to see you," I said. So I guess maybe two or three nights Hailman and his family didn't sleep in their tipi--they was camped right by us. So evidently they went out
