(Could you explain to me a little more about this story - - about the white people coming and getting these things ready to eat. I didn't quite follow that. The one he was just telling about?)

(Kiowa conversation between Charlie and Able.)

They take them back - - Indian, way back, they take that - salt bacon - they think it bad meat. That's what they don't like to smell. And coffee, too. Dohau's wife cook, you know. They all watching. Stand around watching women. They got chicken, too. Yeah, they got chicken - - (Imitates rooster)

Oh, there's low ground, there's so far to see something up there (?)

Unintelligible words) - these people, other place, with timber, and old man

(Unintelligible - - dobedai - - and his son, about 18 years old, doh^wson -

his boy, doh^wson. They got horse - - a little pony. And he is coming way

back there. And Old Man walking, too on foot. Old Lady driving, I guess.

His wife driving. And Old Man got that - - that thing - - that sharp thing - -
