It always be when it's warm--in the summertime.

(Does the dancing take place when they come together for this Arrow Renewal?)

Before the Arrow Renewal.

(OK. But it's when they all come together for that?)

Not every time. They haven't had it for so long since all the old members are dying off. They don't know how to go at it anymore.

All clans.

(Before it died out, though, they did have these dances at the time they all got together for the Arrow Renewal?)

Yes.

(At the time they were together for this Arrow Renewal, would this also be the time they would recruit new members?)

Yes.

(Would they have this "howling all night" before the--?)

It's not "howling all <u>night</u>." They don't call it that. It's just that evening--just that day. And maybe in the evening they'll take the tipi away. That's the end of it.

(You mean that when they're beating the drum and trying to attract new members, that's just during the day?)

Yes. Just during the day. Maybe just that one day. And then they take it (the tipi) down that evening. And then maybe somebody invites them for supper. And that's where everything starts. They'll say, "Let's have an all-night dance." Or else they'll just have singing there—at that place where they were given supper. They'll sing. But if they accidentally sung one song that's just to be sung only all night—they don just sing it sitting around—if they accidentally start that song that's to be used all night, then
