He married her first and she had two childrens - Charlie and Rosie. And then he married Phil Romeks (?) mother, I guess - - it was Old Man Bosin's daughter. She was next. And then Penny's mother was the next. Her name was Margaret.

(Penny who?)

Ruth: Oh, I can't think of - -

(Oh, that's another sister.)

Ruth: Uh-huh. Another brother. And he married Earl and them's mother - - Earl Palmer - - No. Lucy - - Where does Lucy come in, daddy? (directing the question to Charlie.) Anyway, Lucy Palmer and them's mother comes in there. And he's got four from her - - Lucy and Willie and Martha and Caeser. And then he married Earl and them's mother next I guess. And then he married Clara and he had about nine children from her.

(Clara who?)

Ruth: Clara Mopope. He had nine children from her. And then that's where these dancers come in - - they all dancers - - Dixon and George and Gus and all of those. (Referring to the Palmer brothers dance troop at Indian City.)

They're all from Clara.

(Now is Gus the young man that was over there at O.U. a year ago?)

(He's your nephew, then?)

Buth: No, it's his brother. Charlie's the oldest of the Palmers. He's the oldest one.

Charlie: I think you're talking about Gus, my brother's boy.
