GENERAL SUBJECT: TALK TO BLACKFOOT GROUP ON APACHE
TRIBAL BUSINESS

BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Philemon Berry is probably in his sixties. He lives in the vicinity of Fort Cobb, Oklahoma. He is the son of Tennison and Annie Berry. Like his father, Philemon has long taken an interest in Kiowa-Apache business affairs and has served a number of times on the K-C-A business committee. He is fairly well educated and often serves as a mediator between his people and government officials. He often is called upon to announce at tribal gatherings and pow-wows. He is married to a Kiowa, a member of the Goombi family, and is a brother-in-law of Adolphus Goombi.
